VARIATION: BSA06E Pavement Material Hauling during Shutdown Period

The Contractor refers to the above Contract. Capitalised words within this correspondence have the same meaning as in the Contract.

Statement of Variation impact - Clause 9.1(b)	
The Contractor notifies the Engineer that it is of the opinion it has been Directed to carry out a Variation and hereby provides a statement advising of the impacts of the Variation.	
Details of Variation direction	
Reference	Email Correspondence between the Contractor and the Engineer's Area Manager, dated 9/11/23.
Details	Further to discussion and correspondence between the Engineer and Contractor (refer Annexure A), the Contractor has been Directed to haul unconditioned pavement material from the north of BSA06E to the NLC stockpile on the eastern end of the project, during the Operations shutdown period (until 15 December 2023). It is noted that this is a mitigation measure against additional costs in consideration of unavailability of select fill and subbase at 4W and longer inefficient haulage routes after the shutdown period.
Effect of the Variation on the Completion Date - Clause 56.2(a)	
Delay to the Completion Date	Pursuant to Clause 56.2(a) and with reference to Clause 56.1(f), the Contractor anticipates that there will be a delay to the performance of the Works at least equal with the direct manhours incurred in performing this Variation.
The Contractor anticipates potential delay to the Completion of the Works and/or Milestones. The Contractor is currently unable to finalise and advise the anticipated impact of this delay. The Contractor shall continue to liaise closely with the Engineer to minimise the potential impact of this change.	

Impact of the Variation to the Contract Price - Clause 9.1(b)	
The Contractor provides the following pricing for the performance of the Variation.
