Details	Due to the ongoing delays imposed on the contractor, discussions were held with the Engineer, Contractor and the Company, the Contractor was directed as part of the combined mitigation measures to accelerate works on the critical path with the introduction of nightshifts. This introduction was agreed to assist in the reprogramming and scheduling of the works, to achieve revised priority handovers across the site. The measures are ongoing and remain in place as part of the mitigation. This variation costing is up to and including the 06 December 2023.

Impact to Contract Price	The Contract Price in the order of approximately ~\$1,335,000.00 (ex. GST). These costs include personnel uplift costs for nightshift, additional mobilization costs, additional finder's fee costs incurred, additional lighting towers hired, daily costs for setting up and putting down lighting towers and refueling lighting towers.
Qualifications	The above costs are from 19 June 2023 until and including 08 December 2023. No allowance has been made for inefficiencies of working nightshifts for the above dates, as inefficiencies for the above dates are covered in other variations which are awaiting finalization with the Engineer. The Contractor reserves the right to revisit this variation should other variations be rejected.

The Contractor trusts that this provides the requisite information to allow the Company to issue a Variation Direction to confirm the Variation.

The Contractor reserves all its rights under the Contract and at law.
